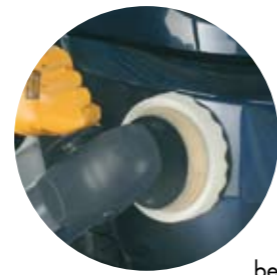


7 tips for good results.

genius

Since its introduction in refinishing, Genius has become synonymous with quick and simple colour shade measuring. The Genius system can be used with Standox. The following tips have been compiled to help you get the most out of your Genius system.

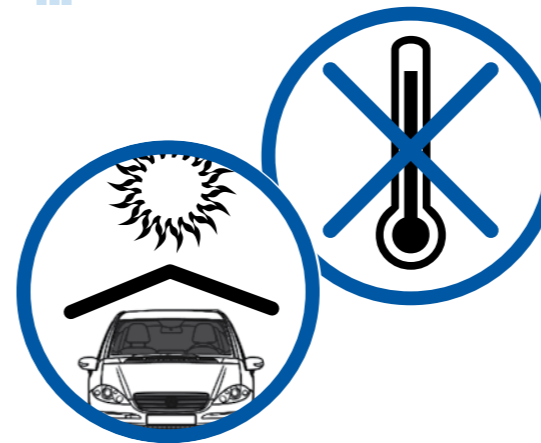
1 The Genius system must be calibrated against the standard samples. These must always be kept clean - please use warm water and a soft cloth to remove any stains. In case of major temperature changes, a new calibration is required.



2 The surface of the colour to be measured must be clean as scratches and dirt considerably reduce the accuracy of the measurement. Clean the entire surface and polish the area to be measured. Remove the polishing film with Standohyd Cleaner. Depending on the surface condition it may have to be sanded and polished too.



3 Do not perform measurements on surfaces that have been exposed to direct sunlight for long periods of time.



4 Every colour shade measurement should be performed at three different measuring angles on the paint surface in the damaged area. Incorrect or rejected measurements are indicated on the display unit.



5 The device must not come into direct contact with solvents or other paint materials. You have to cover the measuring area with the protective cover when the device is not in use.



6 For the best results refine the search with all the information you have including manufacturer, code, and paint series.



7 With the formulation identified by the software, you should always produce a spray out card before refinishing and compare it with the colour on the vehicle to make sure of the match.
